a new charitable endowment fund for disadvantaged children in Cambridgeshire

Cheffins are pleased to be supporting this newly established local charitable fund in their March 2010 Fine Art Sale. They are offering vendors in this sale the chance to help this exciting cause in support of local disadvantaged children. One patron has very generously asked Cheffins to donate the entire sale proceeds of a fine and rare clock (see below) to the Outlook Fund, and in the spirit of this gift Cheffins will be delighted to include other objects that can be sold to benefit the charity in part or full.

Cheffins have also generously agreed to donate a proportion of their commission from the sale of any such item to the Fund. Your donation, whatever the size, will be doubled through a Government matched funding scheme. Your donation will go to improve the lives of Cambridgeshire children that face difficulty and disadvantage, with a focus on the more than 400 looked after children.

These children, also known as children in care, have been removed from their families for their own protection.

They enter care for many reasons, including neglect, parental alcohol or drug abuse, and disability. Sadly, statistics show that they face great difficulties in their lives thereafter. Fewer than 10% of children in care achieve five A-C GCSE grades, compared to half of all young people. Most tragically, whereas children in care represent less than 5% of all children, almost 40% of prisoners under 21 were in care as children. It is a huge credit to the looked

after children that many triumph over their formidable difficulties to build happy and successful lives. The Outlook Fund is focused on helping more of them to do that.

Your donation doubled

Under a Government matching scheme, donations to the Outlook Fund will be matched pound for pound.

How your donation will help

Outlook Fund money will be placed in an endowment managed by the Cambridgeshire Community Foundation (Reg Charity No 1103314). The interest will be used to pay for extra activities and projects that can help disadvantaged children engage with the community, gain self confidence, and succeed at school.
