m376 1913 Fowler Ploughing Engines Class BB. Works Nos 13776 and 13777. Reg Nos. BP 6123 and BP 6121. 14 nhp. Double crank compound. 'Heroine' and 'Hero'.

This pair of ploughing engines were sold new to John Sparks of Yapton, West Sussex in July 1913. They are class BB compound engines fitted with two speed ploughing gear.

In October 1924 they were sold to William Reynolds of Bedford and then in November 1926 they found their way to Welton near Lincoln to continue agricultural contacting for Albert Goodall and Sons. One of their last known official contracts was pulling up trees for the War department at Ingham Airfield just a few miles from the Lincolnshire show ground in January 1941.

It was later that same year they were sold to the Nicholson Bros of Faldingworth. They worked the pair for a short while, before being parked up outside where time and exposure to the elements took it's toll. Fortunately, the motion had a good coating of waste oil, enabling the moving parts to be restored to their former glory. In October 1999 Cliff Spence and his partners Peter and David Ingall and Trevor Watson bought the pair at auction.

The Fowlers then underwent a meticulous nut and bolt restoration to a very high standard which included major boiler work. The restoration was carried out by a dedicated team led by Mr Sam Baines of Bardley. 'Hero' was the first to emerge in 2001 followed by 'Heroine' some years later.

These magnificent engines have just undergone a 10 year hydraulic test and have current boiler certificates. They are in superb condition and should give many years of reliable service.

This beautifully presented small showmans engine started life as a standard 4CD tractor. The original buff log book indicates that the first registered keeper was William John Cooper of Liskeard, Cornwall. It would appear that the engine spent its entire working life with this owner, before passing to James and Crockerell Ltd of Durrington, Salisbury in 1951. James and Cockerell were prominent in the early days of steam preservation also owning the Burrell Scenic Showmans 'The Prince of Wales' at this time.

In November 1957 the engine passed to Robert Bailey of Amesbury, Wilts and it is around this time that the engine was converted to full showmans specification. The Garrett became a familiar sight on the rally fields passing through a series of well known preservationists including Peter Barlow of Retford, R. Baxter of Eye, Peterborough, Phil Ives of Olney, Bucks and Anthony Wootton of Wolverhampton before passing to the current owners.

The Garrett underwent major boiler work in 2014 and is now in superb condition and beautifully presented. The 10 year hydraulic test has just been successfully completed and the engine comes with a current boiler certificate.

This fine example of a Showman's living wagon was built by the well respected builder Howcroft of West Hartlepool, Co Durham. Hallard Howcroft emerged as a carriage builder by 1896 and within a short space of time gained a reputation for top quality workmanship. When showfolk wanted to buy a living van they would advertise 'Orton or Howcroft make required' such was the prestige. This particular example was ordered by John Murphy of Newcastle upon Tyne in 1904. He was a member of the well known Tyneside show land family who toured the North East with their large fair and fleet of showman's engines. It is understood that the wagon was lived in until 1997 and was purchased from the present John Murphy, grandson of the original owner. Since then an extensive yet sensitive restoration has taken place, taking care to conserve the fine interior. A new roof has been constructed in hardwood whilst the sides and belly boxes are original. The whole wagon has been finished to a high standard, coach painted in maroon and lined with gold leaf. The wagon was originally fitted with wooden wheels which have now been replaced with more practical pneumatics. It has been wired with a 240v mains supply as well as 12v battery power and is fully plumbed with hot and cold water tanks. A fully functional working coal fire with stainless steel flue and pipe is also installed. The wagon has the benefit of appearing highly original vet eminently practical and has accompanied the current owners fine Burrell Showman's Engine for many years and has been displayed at a number of rallies throughout the county.

- 1.2 Please refer to Clause 1 of the Conditions of Sale if you are unsure about the meaning of any defined term.
- 1.3 Except where the context otherwise requires words denoting the singular include the plural and vice versa. Words denoting one gender include all genders and words denoting persons include corporations and vice versa.
- 1.4 The Auctioneers may supplement or supersede these Conditions in whole or part with Special Conditions applicable to a specific sale or Lot which will be announced at the time of sale. No employee or agent of the Auctioneers has any authority to vary these Conditions.

Buyers Premiun

- 2.1 All purchases will be subject to the following buyer's premium on Lots sold by auction or by private treaty: Tractors, Steam Engines & Vehicles – 6% + VAT.
 All other items – 10% + VAT.
- 2.2 VAT at the standard rate will be charged on all charges except those detailed in 4.2 below.

3. Entry to the Sale Site

- 3.1 Any person entering the Sale Site does so at their own risk.
- 3.2 Any person entering the Sale Site must comply with the requirements of all Health and Safety notices.
- 3.3 The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse admission to any person or entry of any Lots in to the Sale without giving any reason.

4. Value Added Tax

- 4.1 VAT at the standard UK rate will be added to the hammer price on all Lots unless the Lot is sold under either the Margin Scheme (including second hand vehicles) or the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme when VAT will not be added separately to the hammer price. Under the Margin Scheme or the Auctioneers' Margin Scheme, the Buyer's Premium will be shown inclusive of VAT which cannot be reclaimed as input tax. The Auctioneers may choose, entirely at their discretion, to use one or both of these Schemes in any Auction for eligible items. Lots included under one of these schemes will be marked in the catalogue with either an 'M' or an 'A'. The only other exception will be in the case of 'zero-rated' or 'exempt' items which will be marked in the catalogue with either a 'Z' or an 'E' and will not attract VAT. Prospective Purchasers should check with the Auctioneers before bidding if they are unsure in to which category any Lot falls. - 4.2 Purchasers from the European Community countries outside the UK who are registered for VAT or its equivalent in their member state will be required to supply the Auctioneers with their VAT/FISCAL number and a copy of their VAT registration certificate. Once the VAT number and customer details have been checked by the Auctioneers with the Europa website, any standard rated items, together with any Buyer's Premium charged thereon, may be zero rated for UK VAT purposes. The zero rating of items purchased is also subject to the auctioneers receiving valid proof that the items have been removed from the UK and delivered to the Purchaser's address in another EU member state within the required time limits. If acceptable evidence is not received within these time limits, VAT at the standard UK rate will become payable and will not be recoverable by the purchaser. Details of the evidence required and the time limits are available from the Auctioneer's office. A VAT Deposit equivalent to the UK standard rate of VAT may be taken in some circumstances entirely at the discretion of the Auctioneers. Once all the required evidence of removal from the UK has been received within the time limits, this Deposit will be returned to the Purchaser. If the evidence is not received on time or is insufficient, the VAT Deposit will be paid over to HMRC as VAT. Where any of the above VAT registeration information is not made available to the Auctioneers or where the Purchaser is not VAT registered for VAT in their member state, VAT at the standard UK rate will be charged on all standard rated items and this will not be recoverable.
- 4.3 Overseas Purchasers, from countries outside the European Community, will be required to pay a VAT Deposit equivalent to the standard UK rate of VAT. This amount of VAT Deposit will be refunded to the overseas purchaser if the Auctioneers receive satisfactory evidence of export within the required time limit. Details of the evidence required and the time limits are available from the Auctioneers office and will include original copies of the relevant Export Lodgement Advice and a satisfactory Bill of Lading or Certificate of Shipment clearly identifying the goods. If acceptable documents are not received within the relevant time limits, the VAT Deposit will be paid directly to HMRC as VAT.

5. Description and Condition of Lots

As agents for the Seller, the Auctioneers are primarily dependant on the information provided by the Seller and any statement, written or verbal, made by the Auctioneers in respect of any Lot as to genuineness, origin, date, age, provenance, condition or estimated selling price, including condition reports which may be provided at the Buyer's request, is a statement of opinion held by the Auctioneers. It is, however, deemed that prospective Buyers have inspected the Lots on which they intend to bid at pre-sale viewings. Accordingly, the Auctioneers accept bids from potential Buyers on the basis that the Buyers (or their advisors) have fully inspected the Lot prior to bidding and have satisfied themselves prior to bidding in relation to the condition and accuracy of the description of the Lot.

Subject to the reserve price of the Lot and any other bids received, the sale may be concluded for less than the maximum bid. 7. Payment

7.3 Sold Lots can only be released to the Buyer on Cheffins' receipt of payment in full and cleared funds of the invoice total.

- 7.4 As provided by the Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998, the Auctioneers reserve the right to charge the Buyer interest at 8% above the prevailing base rate set at the time by the Bank of England, for any unpaid account.
- 7.5 If an account remains unpaid and legal action is taken by the Auctioneers in order to obtain payment, the Auctioneers reserve the right to demand in full from the Buyer, all legal, professional and associated costs resulting from such action.

8. Export of Goods

- 8.1 Any Lot purchased at Auction may be subject to export restrictions or may require a licence for export out of the United Kingdom, for example depending on the age and value of the Lot or if the Lot contains organic or endangered materials that are restricted from export (Please refer to 5.3 above).
- 8.2 The Buyer is responsible for obtaining any licences which may be required (including any licence that may be required for import onto the destination country). The delay or denial of any such licence will not be grounds for the Buyer to cancel any purchase.
- 8.3 At the Buyers' request, we can assist in the application for the export of goods outside of the UK.

9. Collection and Storage

- 9.1 Please note that all Lots must be paid for in accordance with Clause 7 above. Lots cannot be released until payment (including Buyer's Premium and VAT where applicable) has been received by the Auctioneers in full and cleared funds for all items purchased. Any delay of payment may result in the Buyer incurring storage charges.
- 9.2 At the Buyer's request, Cheffins may assist in arranging shipment of Lots. Otherwise collection of Lots is the Buyer's sole responsibility. Buyers will be required to produce proof of identity on collection of the Lot.

13. Auctioneer's Right to Annul Sales

14. Agency

The Auctioneers act as agent for the Seller whose identity, for reasons of confidentiality, is not normally disclosed to the Buyer. If a Buyer purchases at Auction, the Contract of Sale is made directly between the Buyer and the Seller.
